Coast Guard Roles/Responsibilities for Marine Debris

- The Coast Guard is one of many supporting agencies to NOAA's lead role.
- As a supporting agency, the Coast Guard may assist a Federal, State or Local agency to perform any activity for which USCG personnel and facilities are especially qualified.
- The Coast Guard will notify the public of hazardous marine debris reported by Coast Guard units and the marine community.
 - Broadcast Notice to Mariners (BNMs)





Coast Guard Roles/Responsibilities for Marine Debris

- The Coast Guard has the authority and responsibility to act when there is
 - > A hazard to navigation.
 - ➤ Pollution or threat of pollution from oil or hazardous materials.
